A free tram service (with a stop outside the Hilton Hotel) travels along King William Street and down North Terrace to the west. There are also free bus services within the City Square and linking the city with North Adelaide. Seniors' Cards also provide free travel on all buses between 9am and 3pm and after 7pm on weekdays and all day Saturday & Sunday. Please refer to the enclosed pamphlet for details.
