Our Lady of Walsingham

Details of our international Pilgrimage to the Shrine of our Lady of Walsingham an important event in 2014 (5-8 June, 2014), hosted by the Grand Priory of England & Wales, will appear soon (here) on the International Website of the Order, together with a booking form, at or before the end of September.

[Walsingham](#) is a small village in rural Norfolk. It is home to two shrines: the Anglican shrine in the centre of the small community, with the Roman Catholic shrine based on the Slipper Chapel.

Accommodation for pilgrims will be provided in the Anglican Shrine itself which can house nearly 200. We have also booked some rooms in the building used for Roman Catholic pilgrims in the village and there are a number of small hotels and guest houses in the vicinity which will be available. In total it is hoped we shall be able to make provision for over 300 pilgrims. While all this accommodation is clean and comfortable, please be aware that it is intended for pilgrims: shared rooms are the norm, particularly in the Shrine. The pilgrimage therefore offers an opportunity for members to come together free of rank and background in a simple spiritual environment.

On booking

The Grand Priory of England & Wales will furnish detailed directions as to how to get to Walsingham once you have arrived in the UK and we will make a coach available from London to Walsingham at specific times; we will also be providing some transport for those staying outside Walsingham, but again only at specific times and on a specific route. Those unable to join these coaches will have to be responsible for their own transport arrangements.

Space is limited and early booking is strongly recommended.
